



VOLUNTARIOS ITINERANTES PRIZE II RULES

The Voluntarios Itinerantes prize was designed to help animal shelters carry out a specific project with a monetary and volunteer hour donation from our association.

RULES

1. Any association dedicated to the protection of animals with its own shelter located within 100 km from Barcelona can submit a project for the Voluntarios Itinerantes prize.
2. The VI Prize consists of a total of 1,500 euros and 200 hours of work by volunteers from the association. The 1,500 euros was collected from the Dog&Roll benefit concert, which took place in December of 2018.
3. In order to qualify for the prize, associations must send a proposal by email with the specific characteristics of their project, including the following information:
 - Brief description of the project.
 - How it will improve the quality of life of the animals or increase their chances of being adopted
 - Budget for the project: estimated cost (what it will be used for) and number of volunteer work hours needed
 - Indicate, if necessary, the specific skills needed from volunteers.
 - Contact information for the association's representatives

The proposal should be send in PDF form to voluntariositinerantes@gmail.com, including « VI PRIZE 2019 [association name]» in the subject line.

Project proposals will be accepted until the 31st of March 2019.

4. The VI board of directors will choose the three projects it considers best fit the following criteria:
 - a. The project implies a real improvement in the quality of life of the animals that live at the shelter
 - b. The project is feasible considering the prize amount
 - c. The project is innovative (is possible)
5. The three projects selected will be posted on the Voluntarios Itinerantes Facebook page. The winner will be the association with the most interaction on Facebook (most likes, most positive comments, more shares...) over the course of 10 days.
6. The result will be made public through Voluntarios Itinerantes social media channels on April 10, 2019. The prize could be declared void.
7. Voluntarios Itinerantes commits to meeting with the winning association within 30 of the announcement in order to begin working on the project.
8. Once the project is completed, the winning association will receive a commemorative poster to display in a visible area of the shelter.
9. The project should be completed within 6 months from the date the winner is announced.
10. Voluntarios Itinerantes reserves the right to contact those associations that did not win in order to help them get started on their respective projects if they consider it to be within their scope.
