

# Clothing recommendations

The work carried out as a shelter volunteer may involve physical exertion, getting dirty or a little bruised by accident. This is why we recommend the following clothing for volunteers:

1. Closed-toe, durable shoes like hiking boots are recommended for walking dogs and working around the shelter. On rainy or muddy days, we recommend rain boots and a waterproof jacket.
2. Comfortable, durable clothing you don't mind throwing away. We recommend avoiding thin tank tops or very short shorts as you may get scratched. Also avoid netted shirts as the dogs' nails could get caught when they jump on us and cause unnecessary injury to both us and the dog.
3. We recommend bringing a change of clothes, as they may get dirty or even rip or tear.
